ACCREDITATION

Newark Catholic High School is a four-year, comprehensive, co-educational high school fully accredited and chartered by the State of Ohio Department of Education, the Diocese of Columbus, and the Ohio Catholic Schools Accrediting Association.

CURRICULUM

GRADE POINT & CLASS RANK

Each student's grade point average is computed at the end of the grading period. Courses are calculated by credit value to determine G.P.A. for the year. Class rank is determined at the end of each semester for grades 9, 10, and 11 based on a 3-decimal G.P.A. For seniors, this is calculated at the end of the first semester, third quarter, and end of school year based on a 2-decimal G.P.A. Both the G.P.A. and class rank are unweighted.
