Dear Parents:

I hope this finds you well even through the ceaseless rain. Several updates and clarifications for end of year events for your student are given in this email.

The designated date for the Classes of 2021, 2022, and 2023 to return items to school is Wednesday, May 27. Every student has been assigned a block of time by last name to limit the numbers gathering and to promote social distancing for everyone's safety. If you are unable to make your assigned time, you may drop off materials any time between 9:00am – 11:00am OR 12:00pm – 3:00pm on May 27. If it is not your assigned time, you may have to wait for others to move through the stations. We appreciate your patience and consideration as we move through this process.

Students who are unable to return items to the school on this date must contact the school in advance for other arrangements. Students who do not wish to enter the building must contact the school in advance to make arrangements for drop-off and pick-up of items outside the front office.

Other end-of-year items and summer materials will be distributed at this time, so please make every effort to be at school on this date. Students will also be able to gather bags with their locker contents at this time.

Please be sure to arrange for the following before May 27:

- Masks are strongly recommended.
- All textbooks and borrowed classroom materials are to be returned.
- All athletic equipment is to be returned (please bag items with your name and grade on the bag)
- Arrive within the assigned hour - if it is not your assigned time, you may have to wait in line for the others to move through the areas.
- For iPads (only those not attending Newark Catholic next school year): all cords and accessories included. Be sure there is enough battery power to power up devices for inspection.
- If unable to return items on the scheduled day, notify the school in advance for an alternative drop-off time.
- If there is an ill family member in the household, notify the school in advance for an alternative drop-off area.
