The date for our Seniors to return items to school is Wednesday, May 20.

Every senior has been assigned a block of time by last name to limit the numbers gathering and to promote social distancing for everyone's safety. If it is not your assigned time, you may have to wait for others to move through the stations. Seniors may also "chalk their parking spot" on May 20 during their designated time. Please note this is to be done with chalk only and of course, it must be of appropriate nature.

Designated times (by last name):

- 10:00-11:00 Halloy - May
- 11:00-12:00 McCafferty - Williams

Seniors who are unable to return items to the school on this date must contact the school in advance for other arrangements. Students who do not wish to enter the building must contact the school in advance to make arrangements for drop-off and pick-up of items outside the front office.

*Caps and gowns and other end-of-year items will be distributed at this time, so please make every effort to be at school on this date.

Please be sure to arrange for the following before May 20:

- Masks are strongly recommended.
- All textbooks and borrowed classroom materials are to be returned.
- All athletic equipment is to be returned (please bag items with your name and grade on the bag)
- Arrive within the assigned hour - if it is not your assigned time, you may have to wait in line for the others to move through the areas.

- For iPads: all cords and accessories included. Be sure there is enough battery power to power up devices for inspection.
- If unable to return items on the scheduled day, notify the school in advance for an alternative drop-off time.
- If there is an ill family member in the household, notify the school in advance for an alternative drop-off area.
