ORIENTATION DAY PROCEDURE Students are to enter the building through the lower lobby doors between 7:45 – 8:00 am and go directly to the cafeteria. There will be an assigned seat for each student in the cafeteria where they will find their packet of information and other items. On this day, the only things students will need to bring with them is a pen and their water bottle. Daily procedures and protocols will be given, pictures will be taken, meetings with Campus Ministry and our Athletic Director will take place and each class will have the opportunity to celebrate Mass together.

Several items will be sent home with your student in a packet on their orientation day. Please be sure to ask your student to review the contents with you. Our Student Agenda, which includes the Student- Parent Handbook, will be given to each student on this day too.

SCHOOL PICTURES Pictures will be taken on Orientation Day. This information will be mailed to you directly from HRImaging, our school photographer. Students are to be in warm weather dress code on this day.

MENINGOCOCCAL VACCINE The State of Ohio requires that all Seniors must receive 2 Meningococcal Vaccine for the 2020-2021 school year. We will need to have documentation of the required vaccine for your child's medical record from your doctor's office by September 25th, or your child will not be allowed to return to school. Please feel free to contact the office with any questions.

FINANCIAL ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT We appreciate the efforts of those who have responded with their financial/enrollment agreements through FACTS. Financial Agreement payments and any fines due must be current for students to take Semester Exams. Please refer to the Financial Agreement on the Tuition Form.

CUSTODY PAPERS These are requested at the time of registration for students to whom this applies. This is a Diocesan requirement and we must comply with the policy and it is for the safety of the student. We appreciate your cooperation in this matter.

STUDENT SCHEDULES

Students should have received an email last week containing information about their schedules for school year.

In order to make class sizes work, student schedules had to be finalized to the greatest extent possible. Unless there is a mistake in the schedule, unfortunately we will not be able to accommodate changes in student schedules due to logistics and reduced class sizes upon return.

If a fee is necessary for the change - as outlined on the schedule sheet and in the academic handbook - the fee will be added to your FACTS account, and an email from the parent will be necessary to approve this change as well as the \$20 charge.

- We do not have a 9th period during the school day. It shows up on the schedule so that we have some place to include your "after school" courses – Yearbook, CCP classes, etc.
- Students should be checking their emails on a daily basis now.
