There will be a notification sent out regarding "return to play" for all students who have tested positive with the CoronaVirus. This is a new procedure that the Ohio High School Athletic Association has adopted through working with the Ohio Department of Health. It is very similar to the "return to play concussion protocol" that is currently in place that requires a doctor to sign off on the athlete being ok to return to play. This is followed by a gradual increase in activity through the Athletic Trainer before an athlete can return to full participation.
