REMINDER Newark Catholic Summer Office

Dear Families,

Your contract with NC for the 2021-2022 school year mandates all families choose a method of payment based on parish participation and commitment to service hours. We have established this method to provide additional financial support to those families who choose to give service to our school.

Our Academic Service Program consists of revenue-generating fundraisers only: Bingo, Auction, and Cafeteria service hours. You can sign up for service hours by going to our website www.newarkcatholic.org. The hours must be completed between July 1, 2021, and June 30, 2022. Although we certainly appreciate all the work that is done in the name of our athletic program, these hours cannot count towards the school service hours. Our budgets are kept separate and so must the service hours. If someone is going to donate their service hours to your family, it must be approved in advance by the school administration.

You must choose one of the following categories based on your Parish Grant/Subsidy AND Academic Service Programs:

Every student will be charged a \$1,000 Academic Service Fee if they do not complete the required hours. This fee is applicable to all students, including those who are EdChoice Scholarship recipients. Additionally, there is a \$115 department fee assessed for every student. This fee is used to cover class retreats, classroom materials, workbooks, and a student "Super Booster" for admission to all home athletic events.

Your student will receive your family's 13 raffle tickets on the first day of school. \$300 has been added to your FACTS account for these tickets. As in the past, each ticket costs \$25, and the 13th ticket is free. Since you are being charged for these tickets, it is your decision whether you write your name on each ticket and turn them in, or you can sell your tickets to your friends and family. If you sell the tickets, you will keep the money they pay you (since the money has been added to your FACTS account).

You should be receiving your tuition and fees agreement information via email from FACTS by the end of this week. If you have any questions about your FACTS account, tuition, service hours, or raffle tickets, please e-mail Jodi Snider at jksnider@newarkcatholic.org. You also can call the school office (740-344-3594) and talk to Jodi Snider. Our summer office hours are Monday through Thursday from 8 am to noon.

Thank you for your continued support of Newark Catholic High School. This mailing is to serve as a means to communicate to you the financial "State of Our School" for the 2020-2021 Academic Year. Please look for your 2021-2022 Financial/Enrollment Agreement which you will receive soon via e-mail from FACTS.

The cost to educate one student at our school is \$9,261. Tuition and fees, whether paying "participating" or "non-participating" does not cover the total cost to educate each student. If you are given "participating" status, your Parish contributes \$310 for your student so approximately \$2,701 more needs to be raised for each "participating" student. For our "non-participating" students, approximately \$2,061 more needs to be raised. The difference in tuition paid and the cost to educate a student is made up in our fundraising so your volunteering is vital to our efforts.
