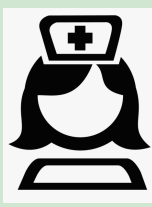

From the Nurse With Covid and its guidelines still affecting our day-to-day lives, know that we are doing everything possible to keep your student safe and our school in session.

As some of you may be aware, there are Covid home tests available to the public for use if symptoms are "suspected". These "home" tests are not recognized by the Licking County Health Department and the Ohio Department of Health. The only acceptable tests to determine a "positive" case are:

- PCR
- Rapid Test (antigen)

These tests must be administered by a medical provider in order for a student to be placed in quarantine. This will help expedite contact tracing for "positive" cases. Your support to ensure the safety of other students is appreciated.
