To be considered for the Diocese of Columbus Tuition Assistance Program:

1. You **must** be registered in one of the Diocesan schools by **March 15, 2022**.
2. **The application, tax return, and W-2 must be submitted by March 15, 2022.** (No exceptions will be made for any late applications, so please apply early in case additional documentation is requested by FACTS.)
3. Payment of the **\$35.00** application fee must accompany the application.
4. Only one application per family is required.
